The Clyde Iron Works were started at Fullarton in 1786 by Thomas Edington and William Cadell and taken over around 1812 by the Dunlop family, owners of the Tollcross estate. The three masts and the bowsprit were stepped in place between September 1984 and February 1985. Warrior ' s engines, boilers and auxiliary machinery were considered too expensive to rebuild, so replicas were built from sheet steel with a few components made from cast iron to duplicate the look of the real equipment. The replica engines can rotate slowly, using electrical power, to allow visitors to imagine how they might have looked in operation.
